

Trial rules and information:

- Masks are required to be worn inside the facility at all times, **EVEN WHEN RUNNING**, & when outside and unable to properly social distance.
- **There will be a parking assistant. Only park in designates spaces. DO NOT park in front of our neighbors P.C. Campbell.**
- Please come prepared to work out of your car. Check the weather and pack accordingly...fans, sunshades, cool mats etc.
- No exhibitor chairs allowed in the building.
- A very limited number of dogs CAN be crated indoors however you are not allowed to stay in the building with your dog. You will only be allowed in this area to retrieve your dog and to return them to their crate. Dogs that bark continuously or are aggressive to passing dogs or people will not be permitted to be crated inside.
- We are running this trial in **GROUPS** to facilitate working. We have put an 8 minute break in between groups and will hold to this so that you have time to work classes and still take care of yourself and your dogs. Thank you in advance for volunteering so this trial runs smoothly.
- United Dog Agility will be providing the Agility Gate service for this event. Details will be emailed with the course maps prior to the trial.
- Course maps will be posted on site as well as posted on Fast Time's website sometime AFTER 6pm the day before the trial. Printed maps will NOT be handed out to exhibitors.
