This will be a CONCURRENT Trial using a BLOCK schedule. NO RUN ORDER will be mailed out, a time block will be assigned.
An email explaining the process will be sent out prior to the trial.

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are registered with the AKC, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program on the day of the trial. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. Dogs may only run once per test

if your mix breed dog needs an AKC Canine Partner number a form is available on page 5 in this Premium. An additional \$19 check made to the AKC along with the form will be submitted along with your results.

All entries must be accompanied with a check to be valid. A returned check is not a valid entry.

Hours

Grounds will be available one hour prior to trial hours. Trial hours are either 8:00 or 9:00AM until 3:00PM or until all runs are completed. It is **also the responsibility of each entrant to be ready with catcher and releaser when their dog is called to the line.**

Check in & Inspection

You may check in for inspection prior a half hour prior to the beginning of the trial, or throughout the event. Every dog must pass through inspection before each run. Dogs who miss roll call will be skipped. If you do not check in within one hour prior to the end of the trial closing, we will assume you are absent. No refunds for absent dogs. At inspection, all dogs will be examined for disqualifications. Bitches known to be in season are not to be brought to the test. At inspection, bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded.

Prizes

A flat blue ribbon for a passing qualifying run.
Rosettes for completing titles BCAT, DCAT or FCAT, as available.
Please notify the Trial Secretary in advance if you anticipate completing a title by writing in on the bottom of the entry form.

What is the Fast CAT?

1. Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs.
2. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually.
3. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).
4. Based on the dog's size at the withers a handicap is applied and points are earned:
 - 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
 - 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
 - Under 12" = Handicap is 2.0.
5. **FORMULA: MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS**
6. Titles are earned at specific point levels
BCAT = 150 points, DCAT = 500 points, FCAT = 1,000 points
FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

***ACCORDING TO AKC RULES; Handlers are not permitted to run with a dog during an official run but must remain either at the start or finish area of the course. Handlers are not to allow dogs to be enticed through the course with anything other than the lure during its official run. NO mechanically devices including whistles, horns, bull horns, etc. or toys including the waving of objects to lure the dog to the finish line. You MAY CHEER and use the dog's name only.**

From the NJ Turnpike: Take exit 7A to 195 East. After 5.5 miles take Exit 11 (Cox's Corner/Imlaystown.) As you exit, keep left. Go to the stop sign and make a right onto Route 524. Go 1.4 miles to the entrance of the Horse Park on the left.

From the Garden State Parkway: Take exit 98 to Route 195 and go west to exit 11. As you exit, keep to the right. Go to the stop sign and make a right onto Route 524. Go 1.4 miles to the entrance of the Horse Park on the left.

- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.
- **ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK**
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly.
- An electric and electronic timing system will be used.
- The show grounds are not completely fenced. The FAST CAT course will be fenced.
- On site port o johns are available.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- **A fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing, or an exhibitor caught not picking up after**

their dog.

- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. **Entry fees will be refunded.**
- The Hunt master is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. He/She has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/GCKC/dog(s) or person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site by the Field Committee, maybe disciplined by the AKC, and **entry fees will not be refunded.**
- **No entry fees will be refunded** if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of The Horse Park of New Jersey at Stone Tavern, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as “The Horse Park”) allowing me, the undersigned, to participate or attend in any capacity (including, but not limited to, as an event manager, rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a Horse Park sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities, or as a spectator, vendor, food service provider; I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the “Agreement”):

A. **RULES AND REGULATIONS:** I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of The Horse Park as published in the Horse Park contract allowing the event I am attending and on the website of the Horse Park, including any special COVID 19 rules and restrictions set forth by federal, state or local governments, the Horse Park, the Department of Agriculture or any other appropriate authority, as attached to this waiver and as amended from time to time.

B. **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISK:** I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any equestrian activity involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances, accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of The Horse Park organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers (“**Risks**”), as well as the risks inherent to any event where exposure to COVID 19 exists. .

EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Horse Park event, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any Horse Park Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any Horse Park event. I also understand the risks related to attending an event in any capacity where other people are or have been present during the COVID 19 pandemic and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such risks and responsibility related thereto.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any Horse Park Event, I hereby release, waive, and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any Horse Park Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the Horse Park Event; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties, and specifically The Horse Park (Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("Liability") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my presence at or any activity related, directly or indirectly to participation in any Horse Park, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.
